JUST TRYAN IT COMPLETES SECOND ANNUAL TRIATHLON RACE IN CHAPEL HILL WITHOUT A DRY EYE IN THE CROWD, DONATES MORE THAN \$90,000 TO AREA HOSPITALS

(Bethesda, MD, Monday, May 22, 2017) - Ryan Darby was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia in December of 2009. During treatment, it was tough, his body took a toll. He got headaches, pain in his knees and pain in his back. During that time, he received so much love and support from family and friends. That support inspired his loved ones to start a foundation, and [JUST TRYAN IT](#) was born. In the last eight years has transpired into a movement.

A second annual Chapel Hill race took place the morning of Sunday, May 21 at [Chapel Hill Country Club](#).
